Key Volunteer Awards

Each nomination must have a narrative essay of why they deserve the award of at LEAST 150 words. The following categories are being added: Corporate, Outstanding Board Member, and Perseverance in Volunteerism.

The Corporate award honors a corporation or business that has made a substantial impact in the community by promoting service to their employees by providing volunteer hours or engaging in other volunteer activities.

The Outstanding Board Member award honors individuals who dedicate their time and expertise to serve on a nonprofit board.

The Perseverance in Volunteerism award honors volunteers who have overcome significant personal, mental, and/or physical obstacles in order to engage in service to others.

We are planning to host an event for both the Governor's Volunteer Service Awards, and our Key Volunteer of the Year Awards in mid May of this year.
